Terre Blanche is a white Rhone blend comprised of Viognier and Roussanne grapes grown on the Westside of Paso Robles in the acclaimed Denner Vineyard.

VINIFICATION

Fermented in neutral oak barrels. Stirred the lees throughout malolactic fermentation. The wine went through full malolactic fermentation and was bottled after 8 months in neutral French oak barrels.

Beeswax, white flowers, clementine, Meyer lemon, orange zest, slate, wet stone, marzipan, sea breeze, brown butter, dried pineapple
