



2014 TERRE BLANCHE

Terre Blanche is a white Rhone blend comprised of Viognier and Roussanne grapes grown on the Westside of Paso Robles in the acclaimed Denner Vineyard.

VINIFICATION

Whole cluster pressed and cold settled in stainless steel. Fermented and aged in neutral 228-liter French oak barriques and 500-liter puncheons. The wine went through malolactic fermentation and was bottled after 12 months.

TASTING NOTES

Nectarine, white peach, crushed rock, buttered citrus, green almond, saline, fresh ginger with a full, round mid-palate, moving into a floral, fresh citrus filled finish.
