2015 TERRE BLANCHE

Terre Blanche is a white Rhone blend comprised of Viognier and Grenache Blanc grapes grown on the Westside of Paso Robles in the acclaimed Paper Street and Rancho de Cielo Vineyards.

VINIFICATION

Whole cluster pressed and cold settled in stainless steel. Fermented and aged in neutral 228-liter French oak barriques and 500-liter puncheons. The wine went through 50% malolactic fermentation and was bottled after 12 months.

TASTING NOTES

White peach, apricot, and spring flowers on the bouquet. Wet stone, ginger, marmalade, Meyer lemon, and orange oil contribute to a full mid-palate with an energetic finish. Enjoy with pan-seared scallops in a butter and white wine sauce.
